☐ Fight the Flu! One of the most important steps to prevent influenza is to get a flu vaccine.

New COVID-19 vaccine available now! The updated COVID-19 vaccine can greatly reduce risk of severe illness, absences and school disruptions. It is recommended for children 6 months and older and can be given with other vaccines. For more information click here.
☐ Protect your infant against Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)! The new RSV vaccine-like
product provides parents with a powerful tool to protect young children and infants born during or entering their first RSV season against severe illness. More information <a href="here">here</a> .
